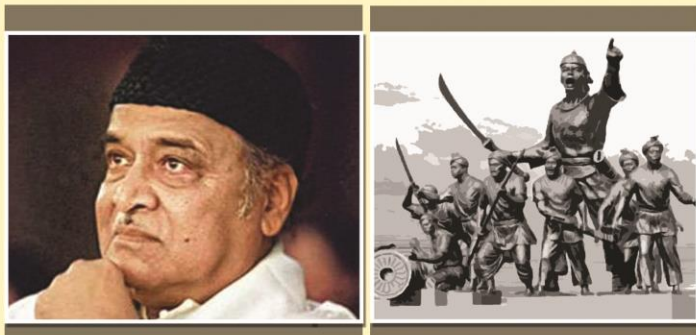
The following activities will be practised classwise by the teachers with the students of classes I to V maintaining a relation with the lessons taught throughout the month.
